

British Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Terms and Conditions

All students must meet all the following criteria and terms and conditions in order to be considered for the scholarship and receive the scholarship.

Eligibility criteria for scholars and applicants

1. Regarded as a home/UK status student for tuition fees and student finance.
2. Has received an offer to study Urban Planning MSc to commence in September 2026.
3. Be able to study full time
4. Tuition fees are not being paid (in full or part) by a sponsor or any other professional body.
5. Scholarship applications must be submitted to Newcastle University by midday Tuesday 30th June 2026.
6. Applicants must be seeking future employment in the public sector upon completion of the programme.
7. Scholarships are not normally paid during repeat years of study.
8. Students agree to engage in and participate with extra-curricular activities organised by the School and the RTPPI which are designed to support students as they progress through their degree.

Terms and conditions

1. This scholarship is not transferable.
2. Any scholarship payments made after a student has interrupted their studies or withdrawn from the university will normally be recovered from the student.
3. By submitting an application students agree to the possibility of their application form and data being shared with British Chamber of Commerce and the Royal Town Planning Institute.
